The big headed ant is an introduced species in Alice Springs which poses a serious threat to local invertebrate communities as it reduces native insects severely, especially our ants. A reduction in

the number and type of our native ants is likely to have a major impact on the ecological services that native ants provide which include soil aeration, pollination and seed dispersal. ([www.csiro.cazr.au](http://www.csiro.cazr.au))

Big headed ants are a huge nuisance in houses as they chew through grouting in tiles and pavers, eat electrical wiring and infest food areas, carpets and irrigation systems.
